Core subjects

This half term our topic is 'How does your garden grow?'

Maths - This week we will be investigating fractions.

Mental Maths- Learning the subtraction facts for all numbers 1-20.

Butterflies are learning the 'n(g)k' sound as in bank.

Home Learning - Please complete one line of tasks from the tic-tac-toe grid over this half term. The children can share each piece of home learning in class as they complete it.

Collect your sunflower seed from Beech Class. Plant your seed. Is it growing? How has it changed? Measure it in Week 5. Who has grown the tallest sunflower?	Make a model of your house (and garden if you wish). This can be made out of any material.	Traditional Tale Review. Read (or share) a traditional tale. Did you enjoy the story? Why/why not? (Present your review any way you wish!)
Write a letter or postcard. Who are you sending it to? Why are you writing to that person? Do you know their address?	Log on to 'My Maths' and complete the set activities.	Draw a map of your route to school. (Can you label all the special features you pass on your journey?)
Can you find objects in your house that are 3d solids? (Cylinder, cube, cuboid, prism, pyramid, sphere, cone)	Research at least one interesting fact about Twyford to present to the class. (You can present your fact any way you wish!)	Sketch a plant or flower from home. It can be inside or outside.
