




## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (VARIATION)

1. The name of the school is Twyford St Mary's Church of England Primary School
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Twyford St Mary's Church of England Primary School"
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Five parent governors
  - b. One local authority governor
  - c. One staff governor
  - d. The Headteacher
  - e. Four co-opted governors
  - f. Four foundation governors
5. Total number of governors: Sixteen
6. The name of the foundation body entitled to appoint the foundation governors is: The Winchester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Parochial Church Council of St Mary the Virgin
7. (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: The office of Priest in Charge (or Vicar) of the Parish of St Mary the Virgin Twyford.  
  
(b) the Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which this governorship exists.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry within which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. There is a trust deed for the school dated 11 August 1843

10. Ethos Statement: Twyford St Mary's Church of England Primary School has been on the site since 1861 and was founded to give a Christian education to the children of Twyford and surrounding districts. Now as then, the school is based on the foundations and principles of the Christian faith as received and understood by the Church of England, which are at the heart of every aspect of the school's work in valuing and providing education for local children of all faiths or none.
11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 17 December 2014
12. This instrument was made by order of Hampshire Local Authority on 10 November 2014
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
