English

Narrative - The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

We are learning to use adventurous vocabulary and a range of prepositions. We will continue to proof read and edit by making corrections, additions and revisions.

Narrative-Traditional Tales

We are learning to use all four sentence types (command, statement, question and exclamatory) with the correct punctuation. We will be adding the suffixes 'ment, ness, and ful, less' to spell longer words.

Narrative -Diaries

We are learning to write in the past tense, using pronouns, time adverbials and sequencing events in the correct order. We will remember to use capital letters for days of the week and months of the year.

Poetry - Poems on a theme.

We are learning to write noun phrases, use the suffixes 'er and est' in adjectives and punctuate our sentences with an exclamation mark.

Fiction- Comics

We are learning to sequence sentences to form short narratives. We will learn to use onomatopoeias, captions, speech and thought bubbles for effect

We are learning to describe position, direction and movement. We will be investigating right angles.

Fractions

We will be finding fractions of amounts and solving fraction problems.

Four number operations

We are continuing to learn our number bonds and subtraction facts (to 20 for Year 1 and to 100 for Year 2) and we will be investigating the 'inverse.'. We will be solving missing number problems for addition and subtraction. We are continuing to count in 10's, 2's and 5's (plus 3's for Year 2) forwards and backwards. We are learning to solve one and two-step problems for all four operations.

Measures

We are learning to compare (using the < and > symbols), describe and solve practical problems for time.

We are learning to identify and classify plants.
