


<p>Non-fiction- Titanic Newspaper Reports</p> <p>We are learning to organize events using simple time adverbials, to use a capital letter when writing proper nouns, to punctuate sentences with a question mark, to use the prefix un and suffix ed when writing in the past tense.</p>	<p>Narrative- Stories with patterned and predictable language</p> <p>We are learning to write short narratives, using adjectives to make our writing more interesting and conjunctions to extend our sentences. We will begin to spell words using contracted forms and use the suffix ing when writing in the past.</p>	<p>Poems on a theme -The Weather</p> <p>We are learning to appreciate and recite well-known poetry and our own. We are learning to write poetry to create a certain effect using nouns, adjectives, noun phrases and similes.</p>

<p>Place Value</p> <p>We are learning what a digit is and to understand the value of each digit(ones, tens hundreds). We are investigating odd and even numbers.</p>	<p>Addition, Subtraction and Multiplication</p> <p>We are investigating number bonds to 10. We are learning to subtract one and two digit numbers to 20. We are learning to solve one-step multiplication problems.</p>	<p>Measures and Shape</p> <p>We are comparing, describing and solving practical problems for weight. We are learning to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour. We are learning to recognise and name common 2d shapes.</p>
