Non-fiction- Titanic Newspaper Reports

We are learning to organize events using time adverbials, to use a capital letter when writing proper nouns, to punctuate sentences with a question mark, to use the prefix un and suffix ed when writing in the past tense. We will use the suffixes er/est to in adjectives and subordinating conjunctions to expand our sentences.

Narrative- The Circus Ship

We are learning to write narratives, using adjectives to make our writing more interesting and adverbs to describe verbs. We will begin to spell words using contracted forms and use the suffixes ing and ed when writing in the past. We will also use different sentence types to vary our writing.

Poems on a theme -The Weather

We are learning to appreciate and recite well-known poetry as well as our own. We are learning to write poetry to create a certain effect using nouns, adjectives, noun phrases and similes.

Fractions

We are investigating the fractions half, quarter and three quarters and finding fractions practically.

Addition, Subtraction and Multiplication

We are investigating number bonds and using number facts to calculate. We are learning to subtract and add one and two digit numbers and ten numbers. We are learning to solve multiplication and division problems.

Measures

We are learning to tell the time to the hour, half past and quarter past/to the hour. We are learning to measure time in hours and minutes.

Science:

Year 1's are observing seasonal changes and describing the weather associated with the each season. Year 2's will be investigating how the weather affects habitats.

Art & D.T:

We are exploring the work of landscape artists, colour mixing and tone in order to produce our own seascape.

Music:

We are learning to play untuned instruments musically focusing on dynamics in order to create the effect of a storm.

History:

We are learning about the Titanic- an event beyond living memory that was significant globally and affected places and people locally.

PHSE:

We are learning about relationships, what a good friend, how to be a good friend and what to do if relationships go wrong.

R.E.

We are learning about the gospel and how in bible stories Jesus gives instructions to people about how to behave.

P.E.

We are learning to participate in team games (Boccia) and to develop basic movements such as balance, coordination and agility in Yoga.
