

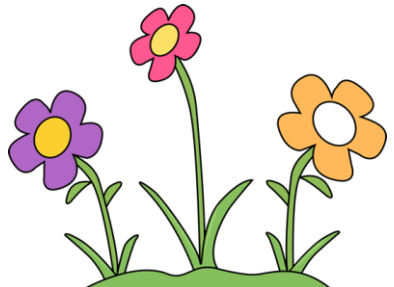

<p>Non-fiction- Letters We are learning to understand the layout of a letter and the difference between a formal and informal letter. We will practice using pronouns and will remember to use a capital letter for the personal pronoun 'I'. We will spell the days of the week correctly and spell words using contractions.</p>	<p>Narrative- Traditional Tales We are learning to write short narratives, using simple noun phrases and similes to make our writing more interesting. We will begin to use a variety of conjunctions to extend our sentences. We will use the suffixes 'ing/ed' to write in the past and use the prefix 'un'.</p>	<p>Non-fiction - Explanation Texts We are learning to write short explanations, using 'er' and 'est' to compare. We will use the suffixes 'ment, ness, less, ful' to describe and begin to check, edit and make additions to our writing.</p>

<p>Measures We are learning to tell the time to 5 minutes. We will be solving time problems relating to 'earlier and later.'</p>	<p>Subtraction and Addition We are learning to solve one-step and missing number subtraction and addition problems, thinking about the inverse relationship.</p>	<p>Fractions We are learning to recognise, find and name a half/quarter/third as one of two/four/three equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.</p>	<p>Multiplication and Division. We are learning to calculate division and multiplication number sentences, thinking about the commutative rule.</p>

We will be investigating the difference between a bulb and a seed and different ways to grow plants. We will also be keeping a 'Cress Diary'.

We are exploring the work of artists and sketching still life.

Music:
We are going to explore a story musically by singing and playing instruments to tell the story.
